

I love our listeners!

There isn't a week that goes by that I am not in contact with a listener of AM 1260 The Rock, in person, by phone, or via e-mail. There's the e-mail from a listener who was walking a dog at 4:20 AM and heard a fascinating program that they wanted to hear again. Or there is the listener who needed an episode number for yesterday's Fr. Riccardo program. We are grateful to know that our listeners are being inspired,



challenged, and fed with the Truth of our Catholic faith. Just yesterday I had a call from a listener who heard something on "The Good Fight" last Saturday and needed to know how/ where to access the audio for that program.

Catholic radio is making an impact, and AM 1260 The Rock is humbled and grateful for the opportunity to participate in evangelizing and catechizing the people in our listening area and beyond with "rock solid truth." The Catholic Radio Association reports that, from 1997 to 2018, Catholic radio in the United States has grown from just seven stations to more than 500. "Catholic radio stations consistently receive conversion stories and testimonies on the power of Catholic radio to teach the faith and draw listeners closer to Christ and His Church. From positively impacting diocesan and parish life, to inviting non-Catholics to the Faith, Catholic radio continues to renew the Church and the world." As Joe said in his story on page 1, "AM 1260 The Rock has changed my life."

We have accomplished so much in our first three and a half years, including the addition of our first locallyproduced program "Table Talk" with Bishop Nelson Perez, the addition of "La Roca," Spanish language programming on our mobile apps and our website, live remote broadcasts, digital and mobile billboards, and our inaugural Day of Prayer and Fasting for Priests. There is so much more we want to do as we continue to attract more listeners and donors. We have accomplished so much in our first three and a half years... Priority number one is to provide a consistently clear broadcast to everyone in our listening area. We are so grateful for your patience as we addressed some technical issues in January that were affecting our broadcast. There is nothing worse than getting a text at 8:30 PM on a Saturday letting us know that we are silent, distorted, or unlistenable (is that even a word?).

We knew when we bought the station that some of our equipment was past its prime. We know we will have to make plans to replace it in the coming years. We also know that we are blessed with so many generous hearts who love this station as we do and understand the importance of providing sound Catholic teaching over the airwaves. Now more than ever, Catholic radio is a voice of light in a dark world, that can have a lasting impact on every soul it reaches.

THE BLACK FAST

With a later Lent this year, we have had adequate time to prepare for

the penitential practices of prayer, fasting and almsgiving. Some would look at our observance of Lent in modern times as hardly penitential at all, as there were those who adhered to the "Black Fast," the most rigorous fasting required in the history of the Church. Only one meal per day was permitted throughout all of Lent and no dairy or flesh meat were allowed. No alcohol was permitted and during Holy Week, the diet consisted only of bread, salt, herbs and water. The Black Fast certainly caused faithful Catholics to anticipate the joyful celebration of Easter!

While attempting the Black Fast in today's society could prove to be extremely difficult, it doesn't mean that we should excise all penitential practices from the Holy Season of Lent. There is value to the old spiritual discipline of "giving up" something for Lent. Often these days, faithful Catholics are encouraged not to "give up" but to "take on" something else for Lent such as Daily Mass or additional prayers. The discipline of the will required in giving up something helps to strengthen our ability to say no to those things that give us pleasure. It forces us to rely more upon what God provides than what contemporary society can give us.

They also didn't have Catholic Radio in the days of the Black Fast. We are blessed to have this radio station, AM 1260 The Rock, Cleveland's Catholic Radio, that provides continuous Catholic programming, 24-hours a day, 7-days a week. It can help to strengthen our will as well as instruct us in the teachings of Holy Mother Church. Maybe we can observe our own Black Fast but adapt to today's toxic media culture by abstaining from all other media except that which provides spiritual sustenance to our soul. Make it a Holy Lent.
