How EWTN Catholic Radio Brought Keith Back to the Catholic Church

I have been on a roller coaster for a number of years in regard to my Christian faith and my return to the Catholic Church.

I am a cradle Catholic. My parents are almost 90 and still attend weekly Mass at St Leo's in Cleveland where I was baptized, received First Holy Communion and confirmed.

Like a typical child of the baby boomer years I was, as Father John Riccardo likes to say, "...sacramentalized, but never evangelized." I attended Mass and CCD classes until I was old enough to say I was going but never showed up. By the time I was 16 I never attended church again until I was married at age 21, yes, of course in the Catholic Church. We had a daughter and raised her in the Church where she was also sacramentalized but never evangelized. That marriage lasted seven years and then we divorced due mainly to my excessive drinking. The marriage was later annulled by the Catholic Church.



For the next 13 years I did not attend any type of church. My drinking progressed, and I became an alcoholic. During my ten or so years of active addiction to alcohol, I was a godless person. I lived a life of self-will run rampant; a very selfish, self-centered life. At age 40 I found the rooms of Alcoholics Anonymous and I currently have 27 years of sobriety.

This is where I started the second phase of my spiritual journey. I was evangelized by a Christian who introduced me to Jesus, and he explained that I needed to have a personal relationship with Him. I started attending church regularly. I started to attend bible studies and became very active in the church.

The Communion of Saints

One of the best things about summertime is the treasury of Saints' feast days which Holy Mother Church opens for our celebration and instruction during the weeks following Pentecost. There are feasts all throughout the year, but the liturgical calendar is especially richly decorated during the summer months, when almost every day gives us the opportunity to praise God in His most glorious works of all, who are firstly the Blessed Virgin Mary, and after her, the holy Angels and the other Saints.

The holy Angels and Saints repay our devotion by bringing our prayers and petitions before God on His throne. As attested by her humble beginnings, AM 1260 The Rock would not exist today but for their ongoing intercession. The Rock has several patrons in heaven who can be identified with confidence, because of the prayers and fasts that have been specifically entrusted to them at critical points along the way since our founding in 2014.

One of them is St. Junipero Serra (+1784), the humble Franciscan Priest whose liturgical feast we celebrated on July 1. As the Catholic missionary who founded modern-day California, he is the prototype of the Franciscan Missionaries of the Eternal Word, the congregation of Priests which Mother Angelica (a Franciscan herself) founded in 1987 to serve as the primary temporal guardians of the Eternal Word Television Network and EWTN Radio. *Thank you, St. Junipero!*

Another is the *Curé of Ars*, St. Jean Marie Vianney (+1859), the humble parish pastor who frequently spent more than 16 hours a day hearing Confessions, and converted and "reverted" many thousands of souls to the Catholic faith by his famous preaching, much of which has been preserved in print to this day. Pope Benedict XVI declared him in 2009 to be the patron Saint of all Priests everywhere. His feast day on the general Roman calendar being August 4, it was superseded in the Ordinary Form of the Mass this year because that date fell on a Sunday. But in the Extraordinary Form of the Mass, his feast remains on its traditional date of August 8, and so we will still have the chance this year to say: *Thank you, St. Jean Vianney!*

There are several others, but in this limited space we must also mention our dearest St. Maria Goretti, Virgin and Martyr, whose liturgical feast day is July 6. With forgiveness of her murderer on her lips, Maria's soul entered heaven on that date in 1902 at the delicate age of 11, because she had chosen on the previous day to accept his 14 brutal and enraged stabs with an awl rather than consent to his lustful advances. Maria is the very model of Christian purity to a world and to a Church which, until Catholic radio came along, seems to have forgotten altogether what purity is and how much it is worth. From heaven she smiles on AM 1260 The Rock's programming and on all who support this mission with their prayers and donations. Pope Pius XII canonized Maria in June 1950 in the presence of a vast crowd which included her mother and her assailant—by then repentant and reformed because of the prayers which she had promised for him from her deathbed—and in a homily broadcast over the radio, declared her a patron Saint of young people everywhere, and their parents. *Thank you, St. Maria Goretti!*

To all listeners and benefactors, from all of us at AM 1260 The Rock, may God bless your summertime and keep you and your families safe!

THE IMPORTANCE OF DAILY PRAYER



If there are students in your family, you likely tend to organize your time about the academic calendar and less so upon the Gregorian calendar; meaning that September often feels like the beginning of a new year as opposed to January. After the disruptive schedule of June, July and August in which travel, family gatherings and long summer days often make it difficult to establish a family routine, September brings with it an opportunity to structure time in a way more conducive to prayer. I have often recommended that one confirm a specific time for daily prayer and that it remains relatively consistent from day-to-day. What that means is that we cannot leave prayer to a convenient time each day as that time may never come and one will retire for the evening without spending time in conversation with God.

Fortunately, there is AM 1260 The Rock here in the Diocese of Cleveland to assist us in our daily prayers. With the Holy Rosary offered twice a day, in the early morning and at night, the Divine Mercy Chaplet offered at 3 pm, and Daily Mass at 10 am each day, it becomes easy to ensure that one doesn't miss the important and life-giving opportunity to pray. Are there going to be times when we don't feel like it? Of course! Yet, I have often said that distracted prayer is better than no prayer at all. The importance of our daily prayers reminds us that we must remain focused upon Heaven and the trials and difficulties of daily life are temporal. Our hearts must remain directed toward Heaven. The best thing that we could do for our families is to establish this important time of daily prayer, instilling good habits and ensuring that we are engaged with God every day – not just when we need Him.



I have always been an early riser. Since the time I was 30 years old I would wake up at 5 am and head to the gym, almost every day. One morning I turned on Sirius radio in my car and there was EWTN, with this nun saying the rosary. I later learned it was Mother Angelica, the founder of the Eternal Word Television Network. Even though I was born and raised Catholic, I had never said the rosary. I sort of knew what it was, but that was the extent of my knowledge.

I then made a point of being in the car at 5:30 am to pray the rosary with Mother Angelica. Once at the gym, I would continue to listen to EWTN radio. I became intrigued with Father John Riccardo, whom I actually know personally today. I have listened to every podcast he has ever done. One morning there was an announcement that if you do not have Catholic radio in your city, to call this number. I did, not expecting too much.

A friend who worked at St. John Neumann in Strongsville was talking about how God works in your life and invited me to go to a Eucharistic exposition about the miracles of the Eucharist, and I was hooked. I came back to the Catholic Church. That was over six years ago, and I now regularly attend daily Mass. I had remarried, but not in the Catholic Church. My wife and I were remarried at St John Neumann, and it was one of the greatest days of my life. My parents attended and what a blessing that was.

About six months after I made that call to EWTN, I was invited to an exploratory meeting at the Holiday Inn about starting an EWTN radio affiliate in Cleveland. The rest is history. A core group met for over a year and then was fortunate enough to purchase WIXY 1260, an AM station owned by Radio Disney. It is kind of ironic; when I was growing up in the 60s, it was a pop music radio station; the first I ever listened to. I continue to serve as a founding board member for AM 1260 The Rock. It is a great experience.

Catholic radio, Mother Angelica and all the wonderful people I have met brought me back to the one "true" Church, and I will be forever grateful.


