

Transmitting the Faith! New Transmitter Now in Operation

While everyone has been adjusting to wearing masks, Zoom meetings, and "social distancing," AM 1260 The Rock has been busy working on the air and behind the scenes to maintain and improve Catholic radio in Cleveland.

On Wednesday, June 24th, we accepted delivery of the long-awaited new Nautel NX10 Transmitter. We had literally inch(es) to clear the door, and without our Audio Engineer Tracey Liston, assisted by Mark Krieger and Leo Burkardt, I am not sure we would have figured out the exact angle that made it all work. No doubt many prayers also helped.

After several weeks of work including engineering and electrical, we switched over our broadcast to the new equipment. We are keeping the old transmitter as a backup to the new one.

Planning for the more than \$50,000 project began over a year ago when the current transmitter was showing signs of stress. According to our Audio Engineer, Tracey Liston, the new transmitter will provide "a more reliable *Continued on page 6*

I am so glad that the patron of this apostolate is St. Peter. He is as imperfect as they come, yet Jesus chose him from among the twelve to be the Rock upon which His Church would be built.



Why did Peter fall? He took his eyes off Jesus. He saw the wind and was afraid. He focused on what was happening rather than on the One in whom was his hope and his refuge.

These past few months have allowed us all to experience the wind and be afraid, but keeping our eyes on Jesus, we, too, can weather the storm.

When the Covid-19 outbreak began in mid-March, the staff and board of AM 1260 The Rock kept our focus on what mattered most: providing our listeners with consistent, reliable Catholic teaching and programming to sustain them through what were going to be weeks of isolation, unavailability of sacraments, and a lack of community. AM 1260 The Rock became that community, offering Mass and devotionals throughout the day and catechesis, apologetics, news and discussion to help us make sense of what was happening.

Working remotely, our staff remained undeterred in serving our listeners, some who found us during the pandemic for the first time, many of whom are not Catholic but found something worth listening to. Together we got through the Triduum and Easter.

We returned to the studio on May 4th and have continued to focus on what our listeners need. For those who remain apprehensive or unable to attend Mass in person, we continue to offer additional opportunities to help you participate in the life of the Church and the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass.

But it isn't just our staff and board who remain focused. So are you.

Despite the financial setbacks and uncertainties that have accompanied this pandemic, you, our listeners, continue to support us with your gifts. We survive on the widows mite, and we know that many of you give from your want rather than from your surplus. You, too, are focused on Jesus throughout this storm.

Not only did you help us surpass our adjusted goal for our postponed pledge drive, you responded generously to our request for funding for our new transmitter, which, by the grace of God, cleared the doorway and is now operating (see page 1 story). If you recall in the last newsletter, I mentioned we were taking a page from Mother Angelica's playbook. She often didn't know where the money was coming from but went forward with what needed to be done. She trusted in Divine Providence and was not disappointed. Neither were we.

As of this writing, we still see the wind; schools are trying to find ways to open, small businesses are struggling to survive, and we continue to live with restrictions that affect not only our daily routines, but our celebration of the Sacraments and the practice of our faith. Together, we must continue to keep our eye on Jesus. We at The Rock are undeterred in our mission "to provide quality Catholic programming that is faithful to the teachings of the Church and inspires a deepening of faith and conversion of heart." With your continued support, Our Lord will use this apostolate to build up the local body of Christ.



Spiritual Warfare

Adapted from a homily offered at Spiritual Warfare Holy Hour on July 9, 2020.

At the beginning of July, during the celebration of our First Friday evening Mass, I stood at the altar leading the congregants in the prayers of the Holy Mass. This was the evening before Independence Day. During Mass, there were numerous fireworks and bottle rockets going off. At one point, I had a brief glimpse of myself as a military chaplain celebrating Holy Mass on the back of a jeep with the troops gathered behind me and the sounds of battle echoing in the air. It's an apt vision for today's faithful Catholics who must be ready every day to go in spiritual battle.





We have the weapons of prayer and the assistance of God that can help us through any

threatening situation or time. We do not need a permit for prayer, nor do we need anything more than the Holy Rosary. However, just like any conflict, we must also prepare ourselves for it. I find the programming on AM 1260 The Rock to be good preparation for the challenges of today. Spiritual warfare does not depend upon how "fit" you are or your physical condition. It is dependent upon our devotion and love for Christ, and the willingness to surrender our will to His Holy Will.

Dan Burke, the former Director of EWTN News, recently wrote a book called *Spiritual Warfare and the Discernment of Spirits*. In a chapter called "How to Strengthen Yourself Against Spiritual Attack," Burke uses the example of Saint Ignatius of Loyola who said that evil often conducts itself like a "military leader" seeking to take a fort or a hill or an occupation. We can see the analogy as a fortress around our soul.

Burke wrote: "The enemy pitches his camp to prepare for the assault on you. He watches you day and night without rest, for he needs no rest. He learns your sins, your weaknesses, your proclivities, and your inclinations. With respect to the structure of the fortress around your soul, and the gates of entry, these are the virtues, or lack thereof in your life. He sends scout demons out to test each gate. They push on them to see if they are strong or weak. If they are weak, the demons take note."

Burke sums up the tactics of the evil one in this way: "The enemy's greatest success will usually be through the gate of your dominant fault or root sin. Your root sin is that one sin that you will wrestle with for the entirety of your life and will manifest itself in various ways." Thus, to strengthen ourselves against the attack of evil – and we cannot lead others in battle unless we are first battle-ready ourselves – so we must know and be prepared for temptation of our root sin. That is imperative in combating evil. Listen to AM 1260 The Rock to aid yourself with the prayers and devotions needed to ensure your success in protecting your soul.


