Praying Them Back to Church



It's a common concern that I hear during my time as a priest, and it seems to be even more prevalent today. Why doesn't my – insert loved one here – whether it is son/daughter/husband/grandchild/brother/sister go to Mass anymore? Even those attending Catholic schools for many years and those who have graduated from Catholic colleges seem to have discovered little use for weekly Mass attendance despite their upbringing. It is compounded even further by the COVID pandemic and the year-long dispensation from the Sunday obligation which has been reinstated. What does one do?

First, it is important to understand that once someone is baptized Catholic, they remain Catholic until a public profession of apostasy. When someone says that he or she is not Catholic anymore, it just is not true. You remain Catholic – whether you like it or not. And you remain bound to the obligation to attend Mass every Sunday under the penalty of mortal sin. When someone says to me that he or she was "once Catholic," I tell them, "You still are."

Secondly, as most of you probably know, nagging someone to attend Mass just does not work. Do not give up, however. A continual friendly and open invitation to attend Holy Mass with you is more effective and likely to show results. You may receive more negative responses than positive ones, but eventually you may get them to attend with you just so you will be quiet!

Third, and most importantly – pray! When we look at the example of Saint Monica, who prayed her wayward son, Saint Augustine, into the Catholic faith, we can see the power of prayer. Do not neglect to include this petition in your daily prayers and do not get discouraged! There are many examples of perseverance in prayer throughout Sacred Scripture. When we feel that our prayers are not being heard, we need to be patient in allowing God to work in His time. We also must acknowledge that God has given each of us the beautiful gift of free will. He does not command us to love Him. He only invites us to love Him in return. It is the same way with our loved ones who have strayed from the faith.

Saint Monica, pray for them.

On July 17, 1995, I began my first day at EWTN. I worked in the Viewer Response Department. After nine months, I was promoted to Vice President of Viewer Services, a position that I held until my relocation back to Ohio in 2015.

I had the privilege of working side by side with Mother Angelica. Truly a woman of amazing faith and fortitude. A warrior and protector of the Church. When Mother spoke, our hearts listened, and the Spirit moved. I was just a kid from Cleveland, Ohio in admiration of this cloistered nun who by her sacrifices and sufferings accomplished great works for God.

Mother Angelica and I would sit at dinner before her live show, and I would be like a sponge just absorbing all I could. Didn't want the moments or conversations to end. It was about 30 minutes before her live show and Mother asked me what she should talk about on her show. I thought she prepared her shows ahead of time and had the script loaded on the teleprompter. I told Mother to talk about the miracle of the fish and loaves. Mother went on the air for almost an hour and delivered an incredible message. I was in awe!

Even my little poodle, Fidgit, knew there was something special about Mother and

on occasion we would keep her company in the EWTN guest house when a Sister could not. Fidgit would keep guard all night at the foot of my bed. If Fidgit heard any rustling in Mother Angelica's room she would jump off the bed and scratch at the door.

I traveled with Mother Angelica to a conference in Illinois in the winter of 1997. As we were waiting to catch our connecting flight, we were informed that we would be delayed due to global weather. Mother just shrugged her shoulders and whispered global weather, huh? We sat for a long time and finally there was an announcement over the intercom. Well, the weather has cleared, however, we have discovered a crack in the wing and are now awaiting the arrival of another airplane. Mother just looked at me and smiled. That evening at the conference Mother was telling our journey story and informed the attendees that she didn't have the heart to tell me that strange and unexplained situations happen to her all the time.

To reach just one soul, one soul! Multitudes of souls from all walks of faith have gained a closer relationship to Jesus through the "yes" of a simple servant of God, who most assuredly lived by faith in the Divine Providence and in the Present Moment. I hope and pray that in my lifetime I will rejoice


