Someone much wiser than me remarked about the rapid acceleration of time, especially as we get older. They put it this way: when someone is two years old and considers



their life, one year seems like a long time because it is half of his life to that point. But when someone is 20 years old and looks at his life, one year doesn't seem as long because it is then only one-twentieth of his life. Volunteer Spotlight: Pat Murray Turns Years of Broadcast Experience into Producing Fruit for the Lord

As the saying goes "It all began at a small 10,000 watt radio station...." which for me turned out to be true! While attending Ashland University, I started my career at WNCO AM/FM as a weekend board operator and sometimes local sports announcer. All this as I was learning about the industry, I wanted to become a part of working at WRDL FM and ACTV2 at the college.

Prior to my senior year, I was able to work in the studio at WUAB-TV. There I was a camera operator, lighting technician as well as an audio mixer. Imagine that – during that summer, we recorded episodes of *Mr. Jingeling* with his winterscape covering the big studio. At lunch I would walk out to 85 degree weather. I learned very early the craft of storytelling through voice and pictures.

I continued my role at WUAB until promoted to a director where I had the chance to work with great local talent on shows like *Barnaby, 43 AM, Lorain Conversation,* and *Superhost.* After a couple of years, I was promoted to directing all sorts of commercials for not only the Cleveland area but national and regional spots as well. This all led me to begin the biggest change in my career....

When WUAB acquired the rights to Cleveland Indians telecasts in 1980, I began the longest part of my career which was sports directing. Until my retirement in 2015, I primarily produced and directed mostly Cleveland baseball, Cavaliers basketball, and a smattering of hockey, college, and high school sports. During that time, I was fortunate enough be awarded sixteen local Emmys for television excellence.

As a Catholic while all of this was occurring, I often thought of the impact the media could have on members of the Church if there was more of it. Thank God! There are now more places to find elements of our faith and how we can grow, but none better than Catholic radio – specifically AM 1260 The Rock!

From my experience, there is no doubt regarding the influence that broadcasting has today. And of all my work, I am pleased and honored to be a part of the production team that broadcasts



the word of the Gospel to Northeast Ohio. Catholic radio today has never been better. From prayerful programs to shows that make you stop and really think about your faith, this station has it all – and more!

Our mission is found in Mark 16:15 "Go forth into the whole world and preach the Gospel to every creature..." At some point after one of the Sunday Masses, the parish priest asked if our college-age grandson had been confirmed and the answer was no. He has agreed to be confirmed and most likely will be joined by his younger brother. Meanwhile, a new business associate invited our son to join the Knights of Columbus. Our son was "exemplified" in the Knights of Columbus in November 2021. Meanwhile, the college wrestling coach's son has become our high school-age grandson's best friend. Both grandsons are attending bible study and/or youth group sessions. The high school-aged grandson goes to a Catholic lunch program on Fridays during his lunch break. The public school they attend allows the students to leave for an hour for whatever lunch plans they may have.

Our son's family migrated out of state in June 2021 to be with our grandson at college, who has a full-ride wrestling scholarship. Our son got a great job offer to open a market for a roofing company.

Update: 12-16-2021:

We visited our son and family around October 1, 2021, and part of our visit included attending Sunday Mass. It was amazing to sit between our son and his wife and his two sons at Sunday Mass, something that never happened before. After church, on the way out, our son insisted excitingly to introduce us to his pastor who seemed very familiar with the family after only a month or so of attending mass. I left the church and realized later that I had left my daily "Word Among Us" prayer book for daily Mass readings in the pew. We went back to the church the following Monday and it was not in the lost and found. The personnel in the office said that the "Word Among Us" is free and to go to the bookshelf in the lobby to pick up a replacement and that allowed me to explain to my son what those were and how he could avail himself of these each month. I got my book back and was able to use my lost booklet as a teaching moment.

When they left us for an out-of-state location a 16 hours drive away, we had thought we would never be able to see them get back to the faith. St. Monica had a different idea and boy was she right! We continue to pray for another sibling in the same situation and we know that at some point, she will return to the faith.
