## *Radio* Home Improvement Projects by Leo Burkardt

Just like when you buy a previously owned home, when you buy a previously owned radio station issues start showing up that were not noticeable when you bought it, much of it because of aging of the buildings and equipment. Here at AM1260 The Rock we are finding things popping up that will need to be addressed over the near future and into next year. As you know, with your help we installed a new transmitter in 2020 that allowed us to transmit at our full daytime power of 10 kw with a clearer signal. That was a big step in improving the station's operation.

Our next big maintenance item is putting a new roof on the building that houses all of the electronics at the antenna site. We need to do this before leaks develop in the current roof which has seen better days. As you can well imagine, a leak in that roof would be a disaster! This will be completed in the next couple of months.

While the new transmitter allows us to broadcast at full strength and with more clarity in the sound, we have discovered that we are losing about 2 kw of power



between the transmitter and the broadcast signal. We are in the process of investigating what is causing this problem. We have five antennas, all of which are needed to produce the broadcast pattern required by the Federal Communication Commission. That pattern resembles an hourglass shape that is oriented north to south. That pattern keeps us from interfering with other radio

stations that broadcast close to or on the same frequency as ours. Our engineer and a contracted consultant are taking field measurements around the area as well as checking the equipment itself to determine why we are losing that signal power. The cost of this study will be more than \$7,000.

One thing that most people do not know is that AM radio stations require not only antennas but also a grounding system to broadcast their signal. Each of our antennas have a grounding mesh buried close to them as well as twelve buried ground wires radiating out from the antenna. The towers are 200 ft. high, and each ground wire is 200 ft. long. In the fall we will be digging around the ground meshes to check out their condition and to ascertain their actual size. After that, some more field measurements of the signal will be taken and hopefully that, along with checks on the equipment itself, will allow us to identify where we are losing the 2 kw of power and any signal quality problems we may have. We already know that we need to fill in dirt that has eroded over the years from around the antennas and in the field in which they are located. The entire project including replacement of at least a portion of the ground wires and the fill dirt could cost some thousands of dollars just because of the sheer size of the job.

When we complete this project, we hope to be putting out a full, clear, and crisp signal. The improvement should be most noticeable at the edges of the broadcast pattern.

Our next project after that will be replacing the programming production computers which control what programs you hear and when you hear them. These computers are seven years old now and although they are not showing any problems, we don't want to get caught with a breakdown and have a sudden interruption in the program schedule while we replace and program a new system. We are contemplating replacing them next year. That will be about a \$7,000 expense.

With your continued support we will be able to complete all of these maintenance updates and provide you, our family, with the best radio signal and programs that we can. We want to keep the Word of Jesus Our Lord reaching and enriching Northeast Ohio for many years to come. As Mother Angelica said, even if just one soul is saved, it is worth it!

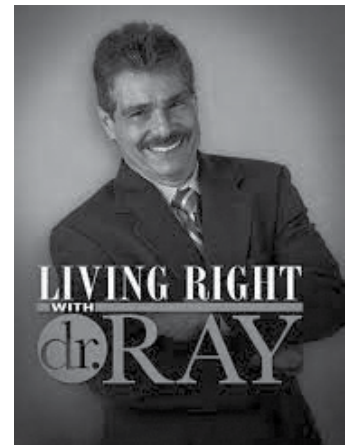
