**Updated AM1260

The Cross of Life

Over the past few years, I have noticed a trend developing at weddings. As husband and wife exchange vows, they intertwine their hands with both of them holding a crucifix. As they promise to “have and to hold; for richer, for poorer; in sickness and in health;” for all of the days of their lives, they have the cross of Christ at the center of their marriage. It is a beautiful custom that I believe first developed in a small Croatian village that is reported to have a zero-divorce rate. After exchanging vows, the couple will first kiss the crucifix before their first kiss as husband and wife.

It is more important than ever that we imitate this love for the crucified Christ and that we do all that we can to keep Him at the center of our lives. As Christ was dying on the Cross on Mount Calvary, He did it out of love for us. When we are encountering difficult situations – some even painful – we too must embrace our cross out of love for others and love for God. We must not try to hide the cross or avoid it or even minimize it in our lives. We must acknowledge the pain of the cross – and the subsequent glory. Venerable Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen was known to have said, “No cross—no crown!”

Whatever our state in life may be, we can embrace the cross during this Holy Season of Lent. Carry a crucifix in your pocket. Wear one around your neck. Have a cross mounted in your home and workplace. Pray the Stations of the Cross. The more we love our cross, the easier it becomes to carry. Say often to yourselves the following words: “We adore Thee, O Christ, and bless Thee. Because by Thy holy cross, Thou hast redeemed the world!” The way to salvation is indeed through the Holy Cross of Christ.

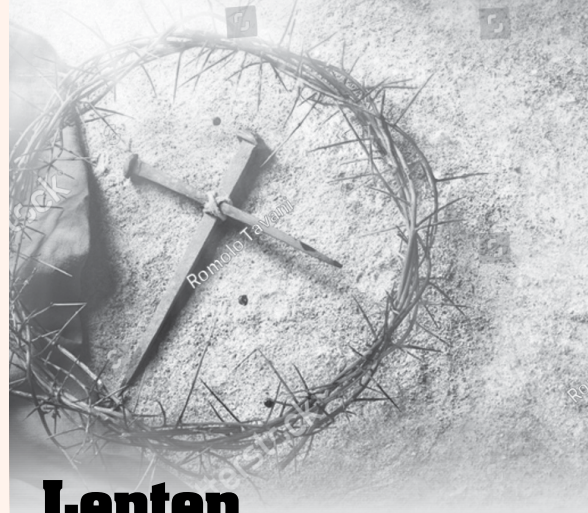
We also found interesting how people learned about the station.

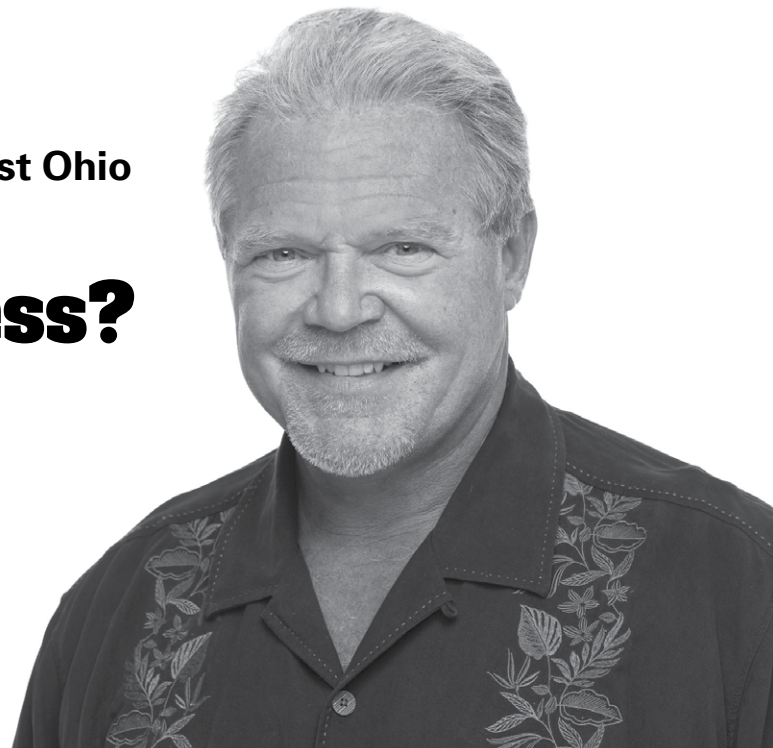
