Lenten Reflections from the Basilica of Our Lady of Walsingham in Norfolk, England

This liturgy, which is based on James 5:13-15, yet differs from the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick in several ways, calls for the community to remember that while oil is for the healing of the body, repentance and contrition of heart is the oil for the soul.
